

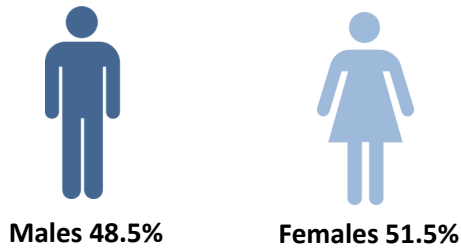

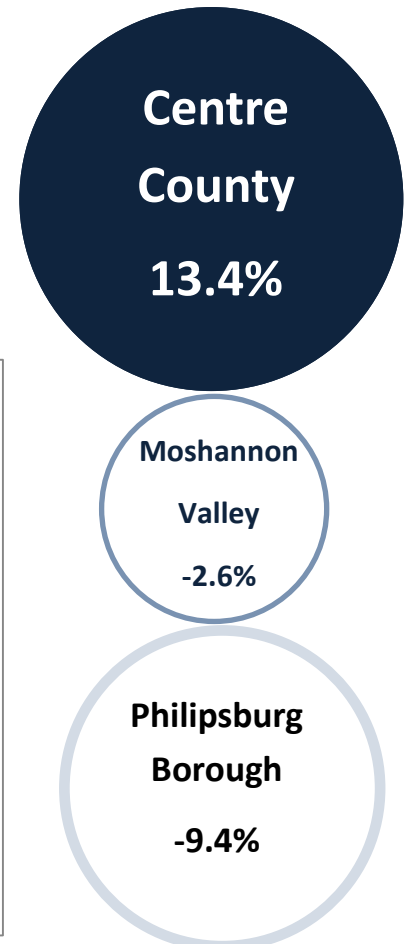

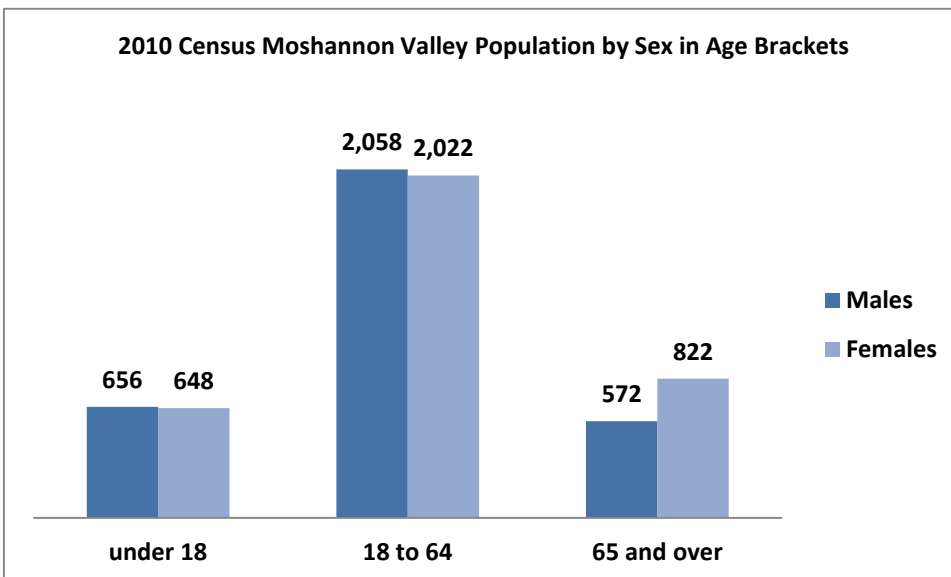
**Population by Sex**



*Population Growth*



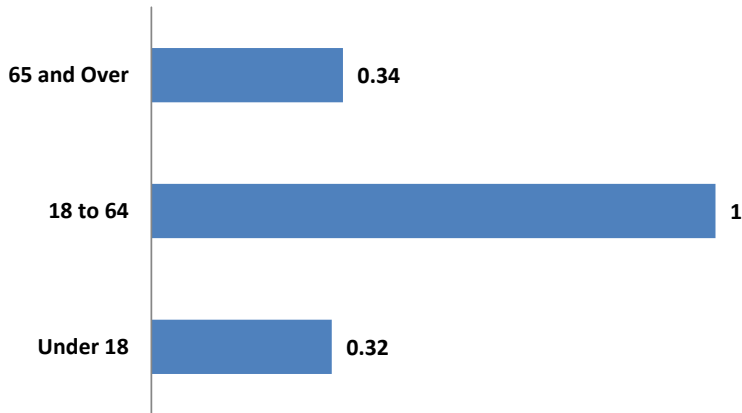
2010 Census Moshannon Valley Population by Sex in Age Brackets

Age Dependency Ratios for the Moshannon Valley



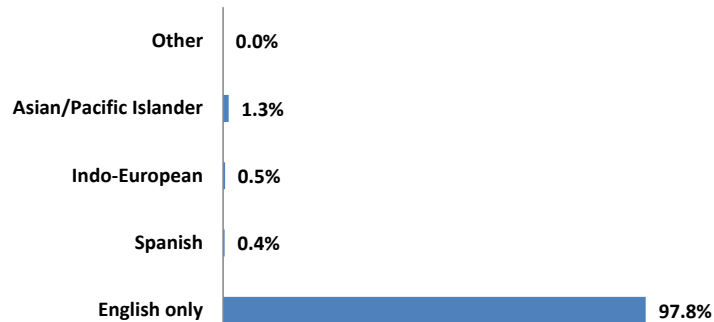
For every 1 adult aged 18 to 64, there are 0.32 persons under the age of 18.

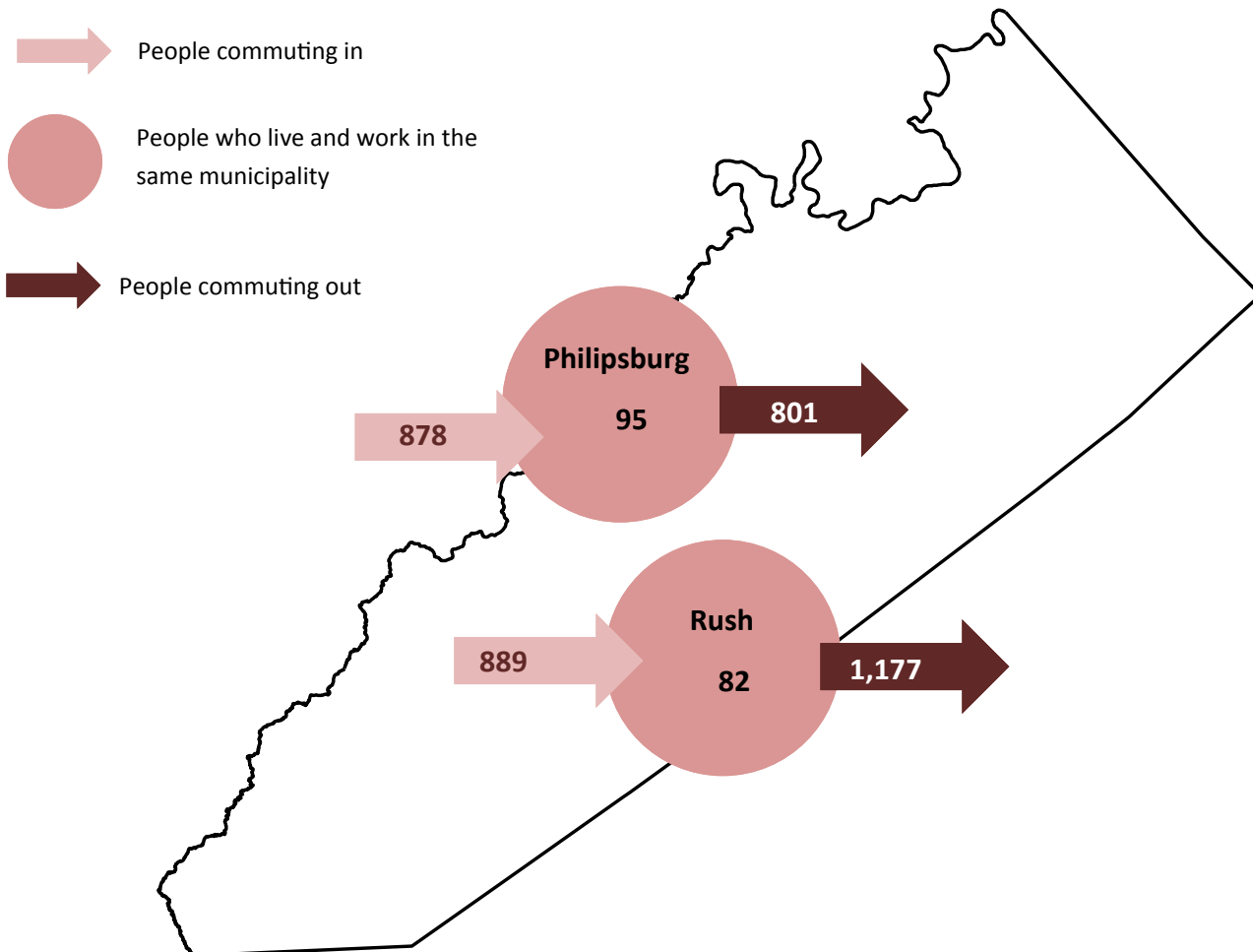

*Number of people who commute from place of residence to place of primary employment*



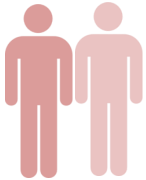

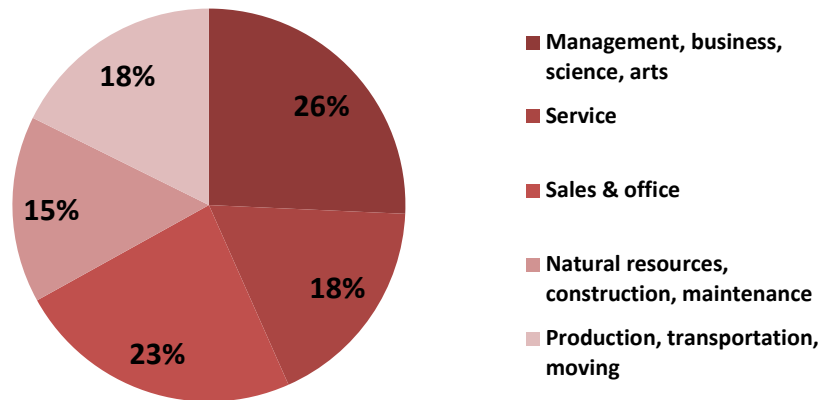

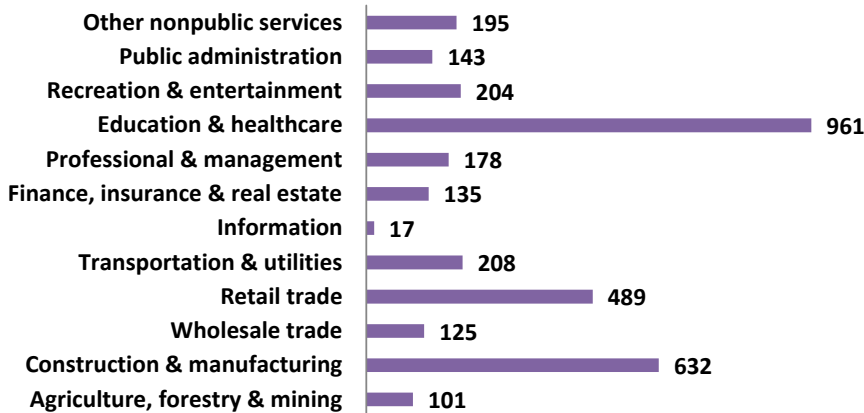

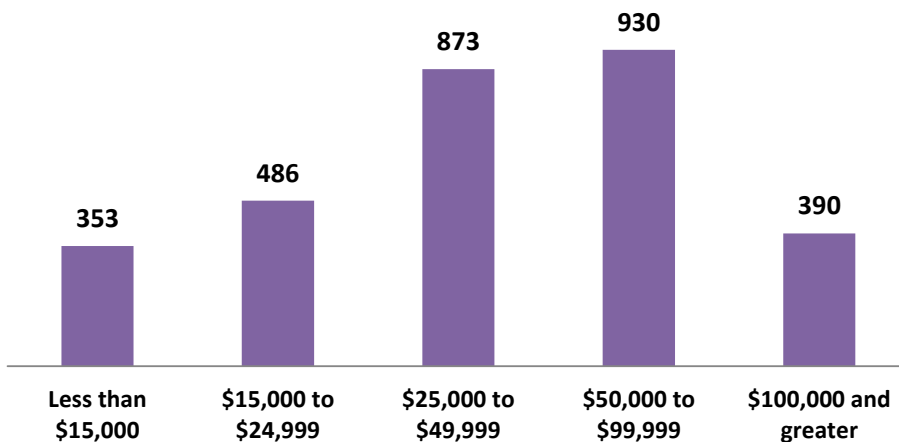

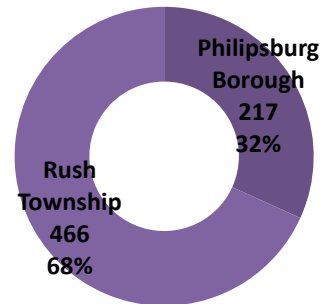

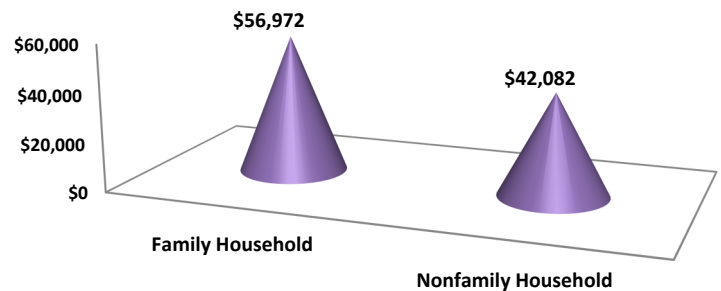

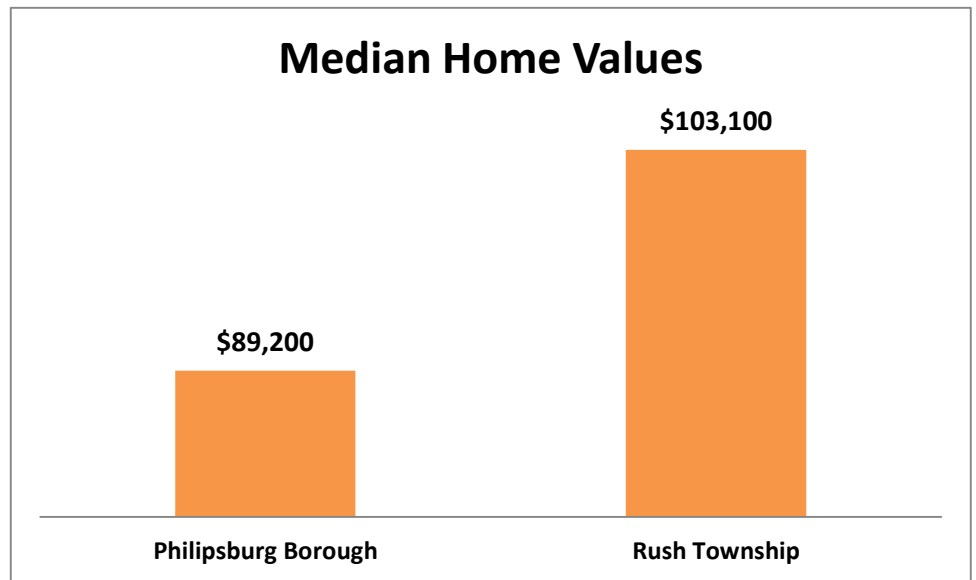

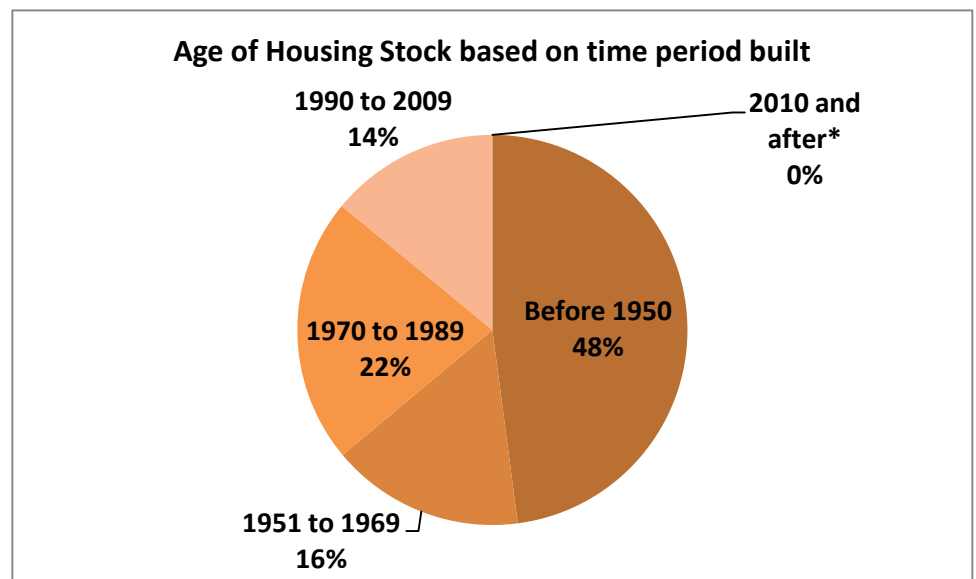

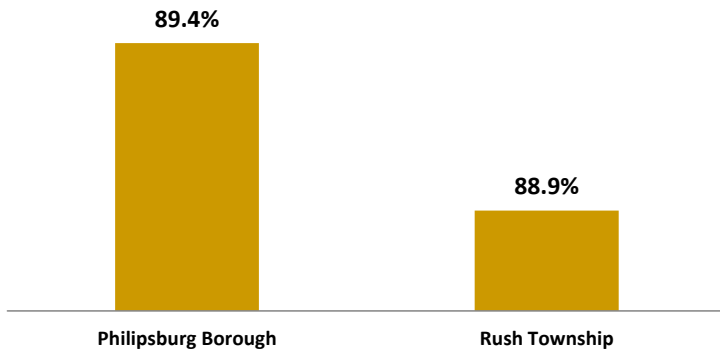

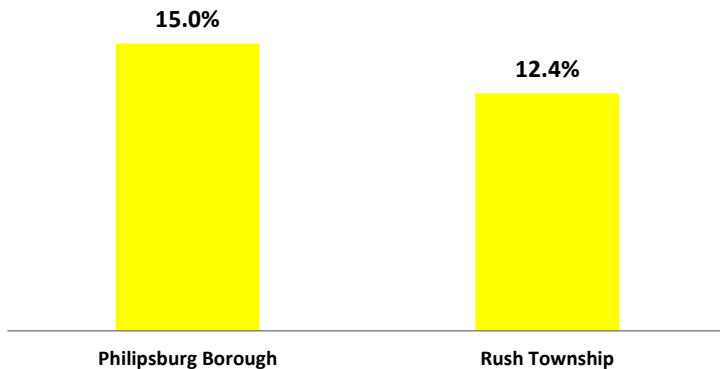

**Percent of the Adult Population age 25 and over with a high school diploma or higher**



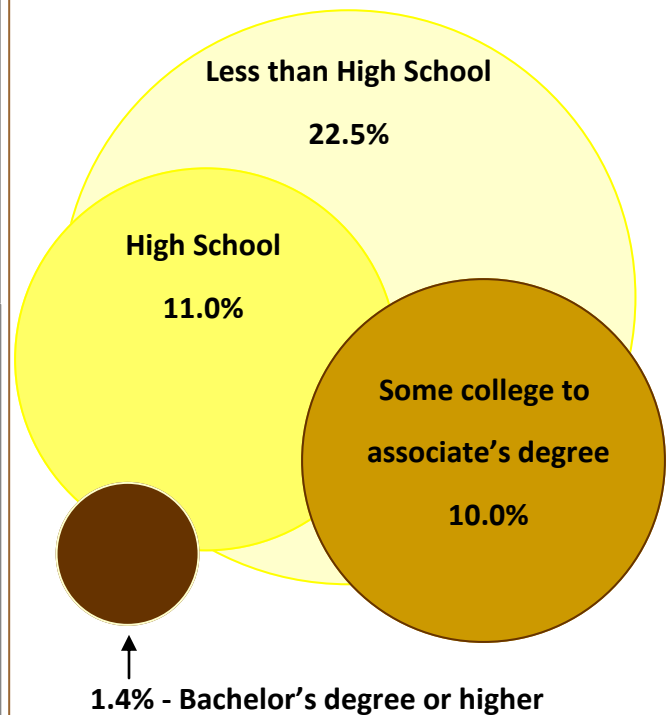

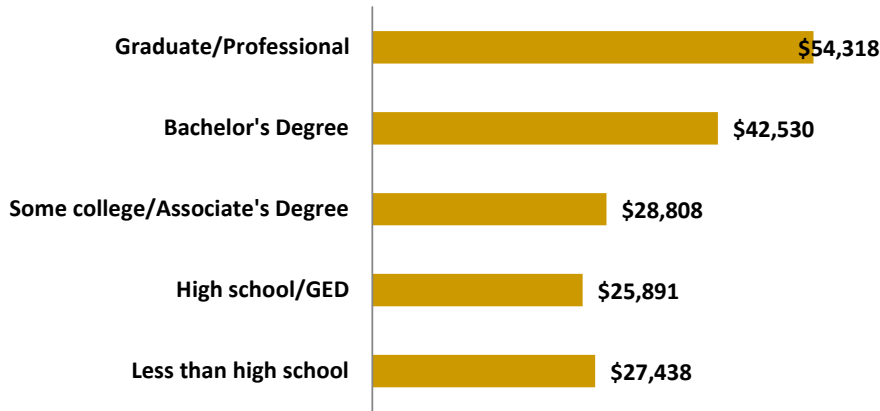
Persons reporting poverty based on education level

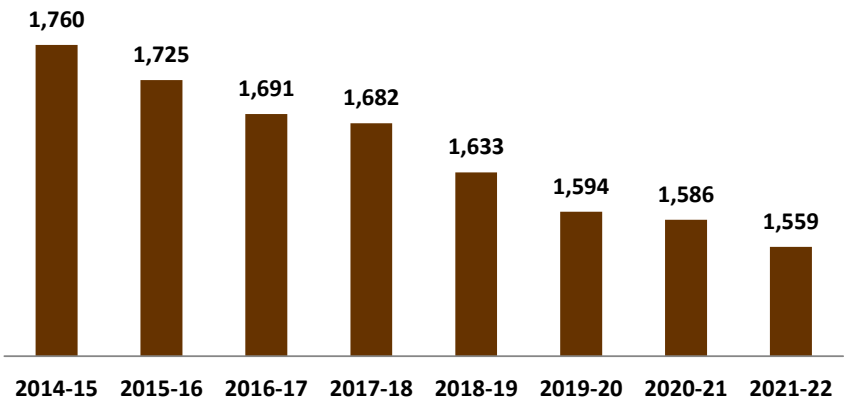
## Education and Median Earnings



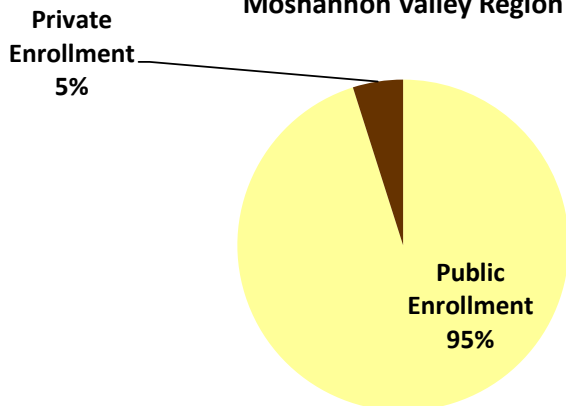
Individuals who attain higher levels of education typically earn more income, which is seen in the earnings by education.
