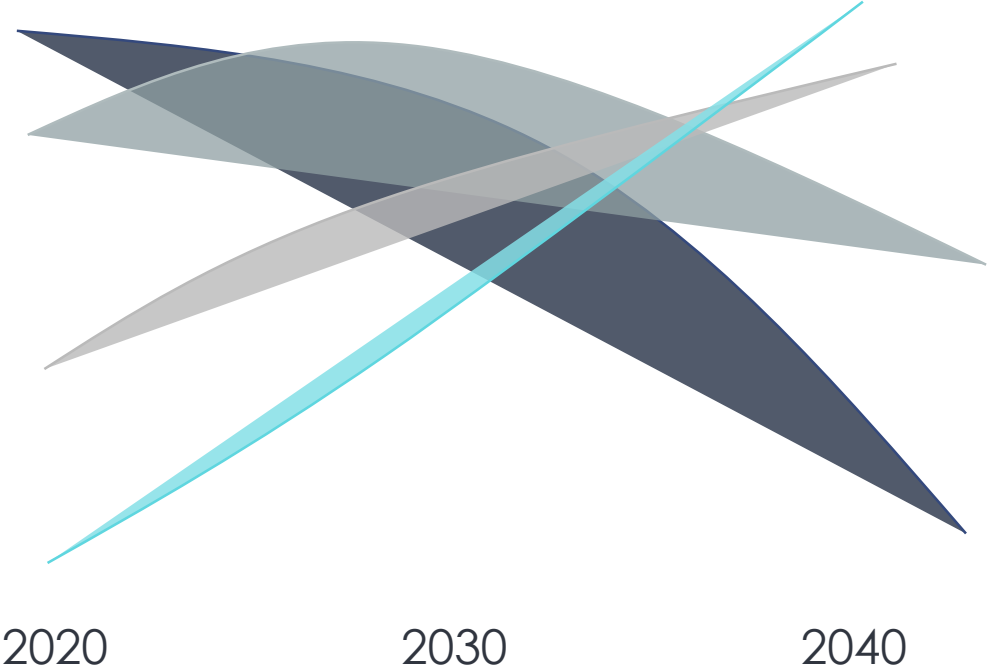

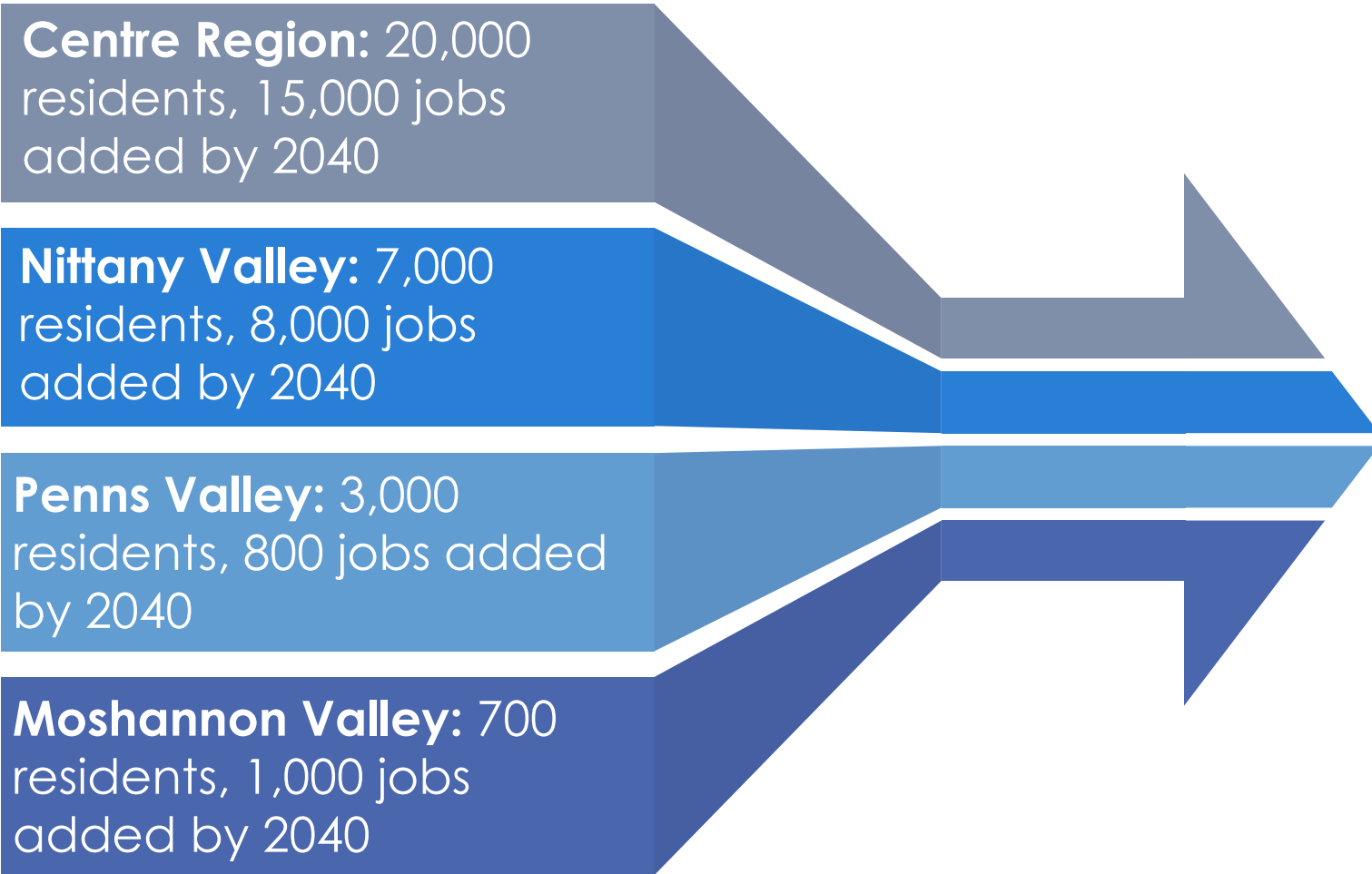

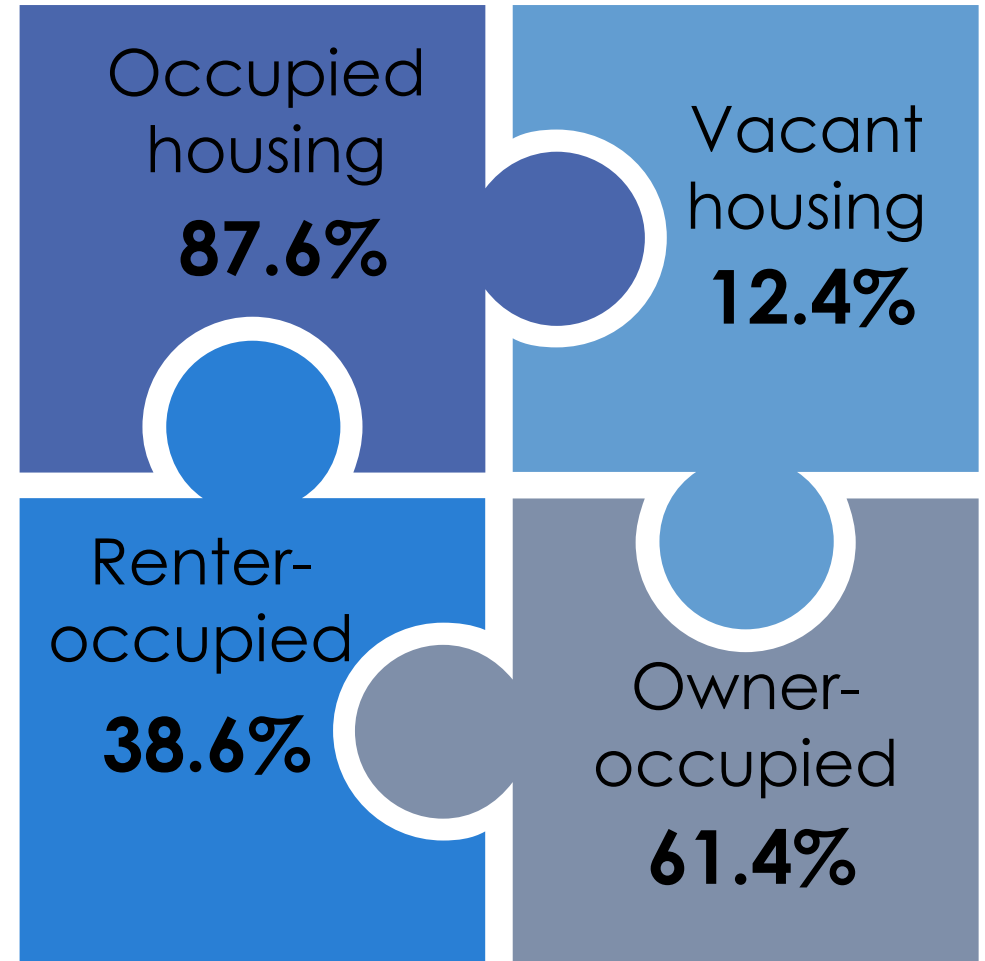

Occupancy and Tenure

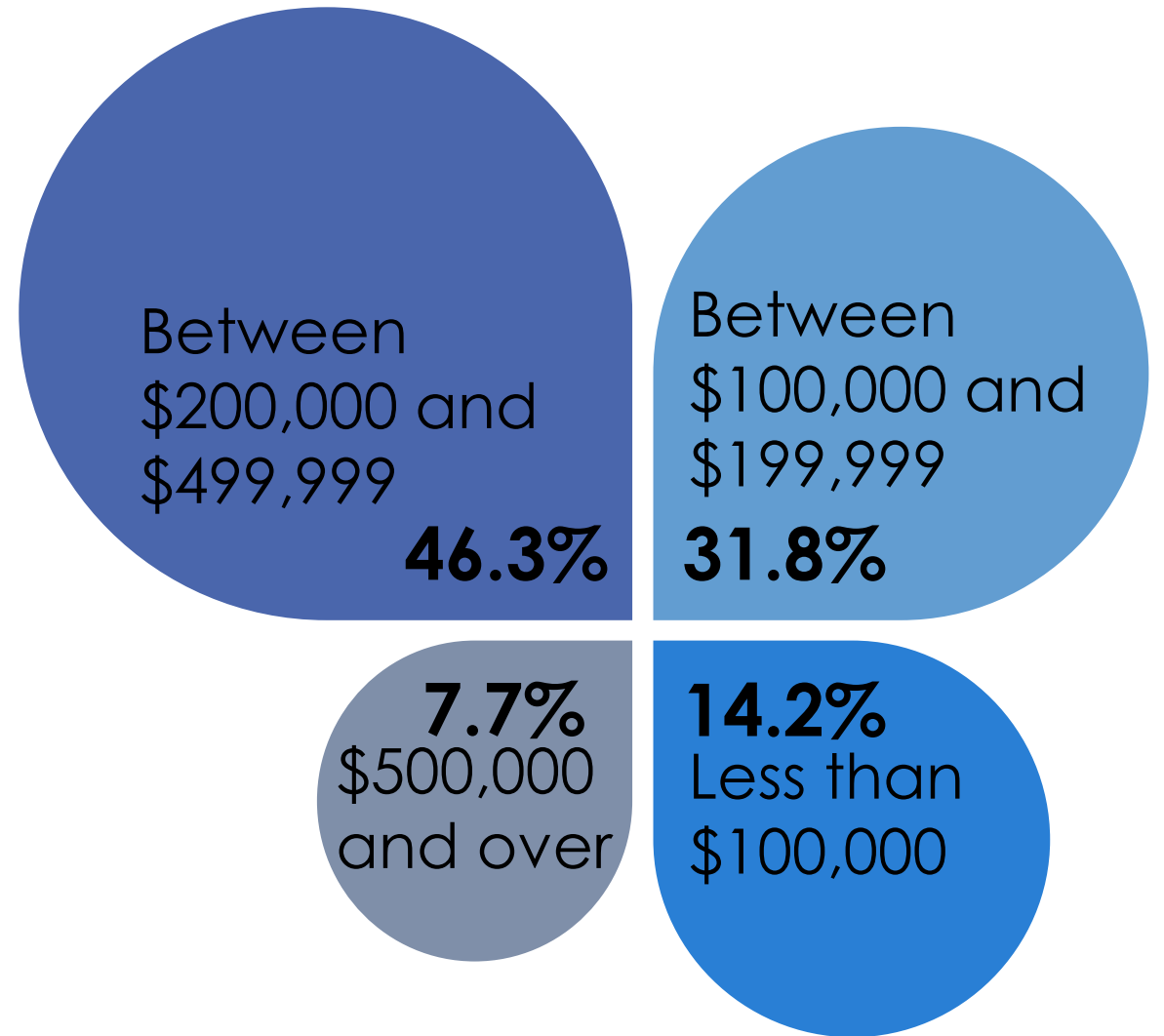
